„Vysočina“ Training Centre

The Vysočina Training Centre was created as a modern base for training and education of employees, with a floorage of 281 m². The Vysočina Training Centre consists of a large classroom, a computer classroom and a small classroom.

- The small classroom is mainly designed for requalification courses. Course participants can gain practical experience in the desired profession (e.g. a machinist, a locksmith, a moulder, etc.) in company production facilities, and subsequently they are offered a job in the joint stock company.
- The computer room is used for IT training.
- The large classroom is used for training in statutory, technical and other skills, e.g. soft skills.
- První brněnská strojírna Velká Bíteš, a.s. intends to develop competencies of its employees by means of their further training. The Vysočina Training Centre is also used for implementation of projects co-financed from the EUROPEAN SOCIAL FUND AND THE STATE BUDGET OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC: "Support of Professional Qualification of Aerospace Specialists" and "Modern Methods of Organization Management with a Focus on Human Resources".

The implementation started on October 1, 2006.
